The club is also designated a Platinum Club of America, A Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary and winner of several renovation and environmental awards.

Interns assist with the daily care and maintenance of the golf courses and grounds. The internship program also includes crew management and an opportunity to progress throughout the season. This position will involve the operation of some motorized equipment as well. Some basic duties include mowing of greens, tees, fairways and rough, bunker maintenance etc.

Skills interns should have, but not required include knowledge and ability to use hand and power tools, time management skills, and the ability to work well independently and on a team. On the job training is provided as we work in a fast paced environment; show a strong sense of urgency and have a strong desire to learn; paying attention to detail is very important. Prior golf course management experience is not essential, however a good, positive attitude is. Benefits include multi-course experience, on site housing with cable and internet access, competitive pay with overtime available, golf privileges and uniforms provided and full time employment opportunities are available after graduation.

Candidates must be available for weekday, weekend and holiday hours throughout their internship, while being extremely flexible and dependable throughout their time here.
