Course Description:

Concord Country Club is a 125-year-old private club, featuring a Donald Ross designed 18-hole golf course, 8 tennis courts, pool facilities and a clubhouse for members and guests. Concord was the host of the 2014 WGAM State Amateur, the 2015 NEPGA Championship, and the 2018 Ouimet tournament. The club will be hosting the 2020 New England Amateur Championship and the 2022 Massachusetts Amateur Championship. The golf course also is undertaking a new irrigation system starting in August of 2020 which will include a new storage pond, pump house and pumps. Along with an irrigation system, the club is in the process of finalizing a new Master plan by architect Andrew Green with hopes of starting the restoration project construction sometime in the fall of 2020. The candidate will get extensive construction and irrigation installation experience. The department is located in a 20,000 sq. ft. ground and environmental management center built in 2012. Housing is available on site in the facility. Opportunity to grow and develop within the organization.

Job Description:

The candidate will work closely with the Superintendent and the turf management team on all aspects of golf course maintenance. The position will consist of fertilizer and pesticide applications, calibration, and training. Other duties will include course set-up, water management, irrigation and drainage projects and troubleshooting. The intern will be part of the decision making process on course management through weekly meetings. The intern will work with the Superintendent on career guidance and goal setting. The position requires a strong work ethic, commitment, honesty, and a positive attitude. Candidate needs a willingness to put in long hours as needed (average 50 to 60 hours per week). Typically, we rotate the staff to allow for time off throughout the summer.

Education and Experience Requirements:

Must be currently enrolled in a 2 or 4 Turf Management Program or related field. Winter school students are also encouraged to apply. Golf course experience preferred but not required
